### CARE AND MAINTENANCE

#### CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Please vacuum or brush your furniture frequently to remove damaging dirt and grit particles which will otherwise affect the durability and colour of your fabric. We recommend that all fabric upholstery is cleaned in situ by a professional upholstery cleaning specialist every eighteen months - two years, depending on use. In the event of any spills or stains on your upholstery we recommend you contact a local specialist cleaning company for advise.  
NO upholstery fabrics should be washed.

#### CREASING & SHADING

As with all types of velvets and chenilles, shading and flattening of the pile is perfectly normal and will have no detrimental effect on the wearing of the properties of the fabric, this can be minimized by brushing against the pile. All fabrics are likely to crease, particularly on the arms and cushions, this is not a fault but a natural result of normal use and will not have any adverse effect on the wearing of the furniture.

#### LEATHER CARE

Leather is a natural product with it's own individual characteristics, because of this, differences in colour and texture must be expected even within the same piece of hide. Natural surface marks that have accumulated during the years of the animal's life must be considered as features and not faults.

To get the best performance from your leather and to prevent it from drying out, we recommend that you do not place leather furniture near a radiator or in sustained direct sunlight and take care there is sufficient air humidity in the room. Body heat also has an effect on leather and sitting may therefore cause seat cushion cases to stretch and puddle where they have been in contact with the body, this is a normal characteristic and cannot be avoided.

Clean your furniture regularly by dusting with a soft cloth and remove any spills immediatley by dabbing with a clean soft cloth. For further advice on leather care please consult a specialist leather cleaning company.

#### CUSHIONS

A variety of cushion fillings are used depending on the model and design. It is essential that feather or fibre fill cushions are plumped at least twice a week to maintain their bulk and reduce flattening. All types of loose seat and back cushions should also be turned regularly to even out wear and fading.

#### HEAT AND LIGHT

Never leave your furniture in direct contact with a heat source such as a radiator or fire. Avoid standing the furniture permanently in a window as sunlight may cause the fabric colour to fade.

#### WEARABILITY

The most vulnerable point of wear on furniture is the arm where premature deterioration of fabric is often caused by sub-conscious body movements such as rubbing your hands back and forth over the arm's surface. We would advise, in most cases, the purchase of arm caps to extend the life of your furniture.  
Avoid sitting on the edges of your seats as this will weaken the front edge of your furniture.
